2026 Statewide Primary and Election Voting Methods

Quick Facts

- The voter registration deadline is February 6th.
- Federal, State, and Local offices will be on the ballot.
- You must vote in the party primary of your registration unless registered as Unaffiliated.
- Unaffiliated voters may choose which party primary to participate in.
- Non-partisan ballots will only have School Board and City of Raleigh races (if eligible).
- Voters who are 17 years of age and will be 18 by the date of the general election are eligible to vote in the primary.
- Photo ID will be required to vote. For full details, visit our website at dcovotes.com.
- If necessary, a second primary will take place on May 12th.

VOTE EARLY!

- Early voting will take place from February 12th through February 28th.
- Avoid long lines by using the Early Voting Locator and Wait-Times Dashboard on our website at dcovotes.com.

VOTE BY-MAIL!

- Request a no-excuse absentee by-mail ballot fully online by February 17th.
- Track your ballot from the point of distribution until it is returned to the BOE.

VOTE ON ELECTION DAY!

- Election Day voting will occur on March 3rd at your home precinct's polling place.
- The polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.
